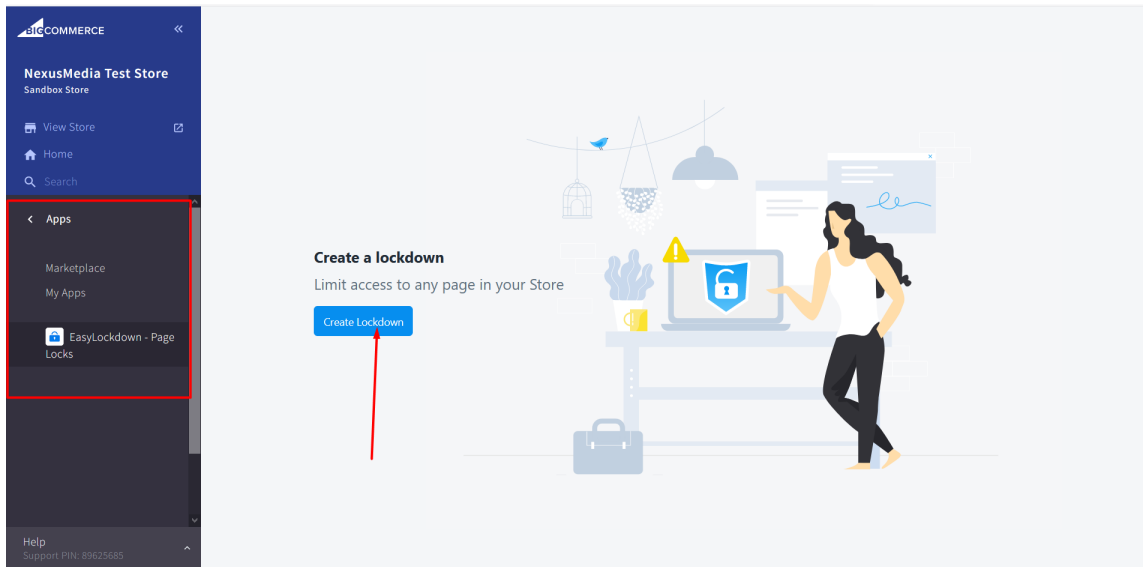
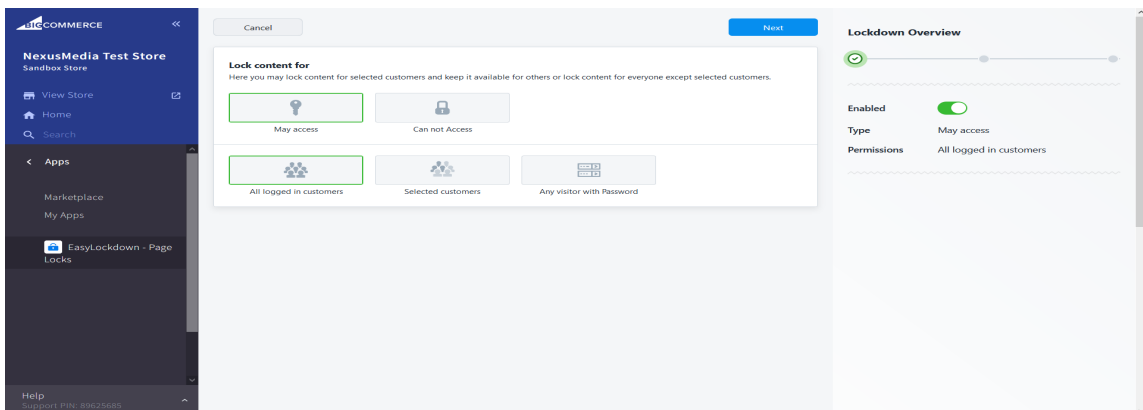


# EasyLockdown - Page Locks. User Guide

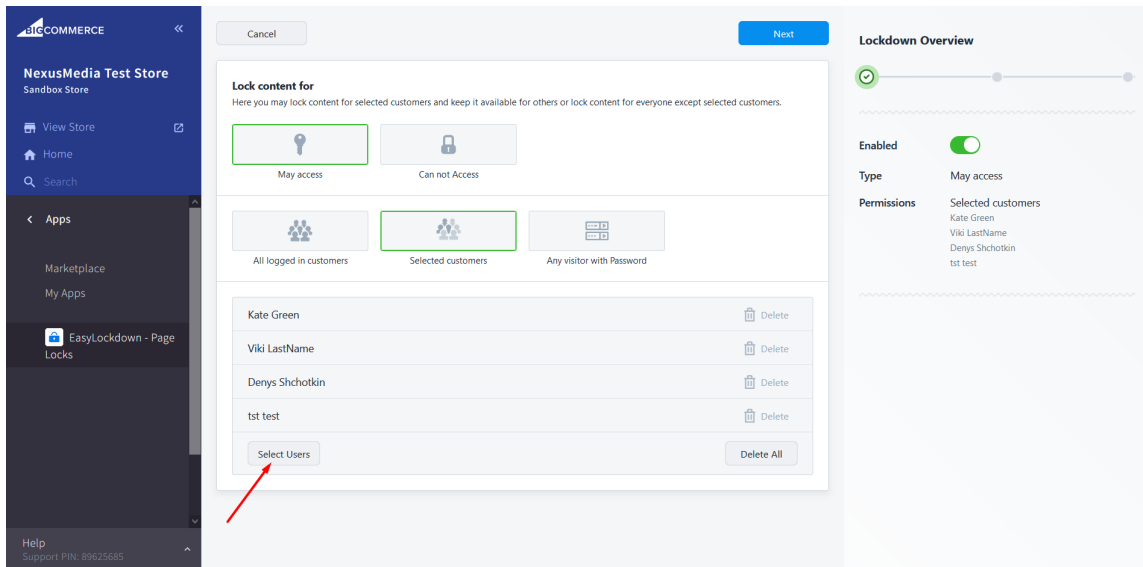
## 1. Create your first lock.



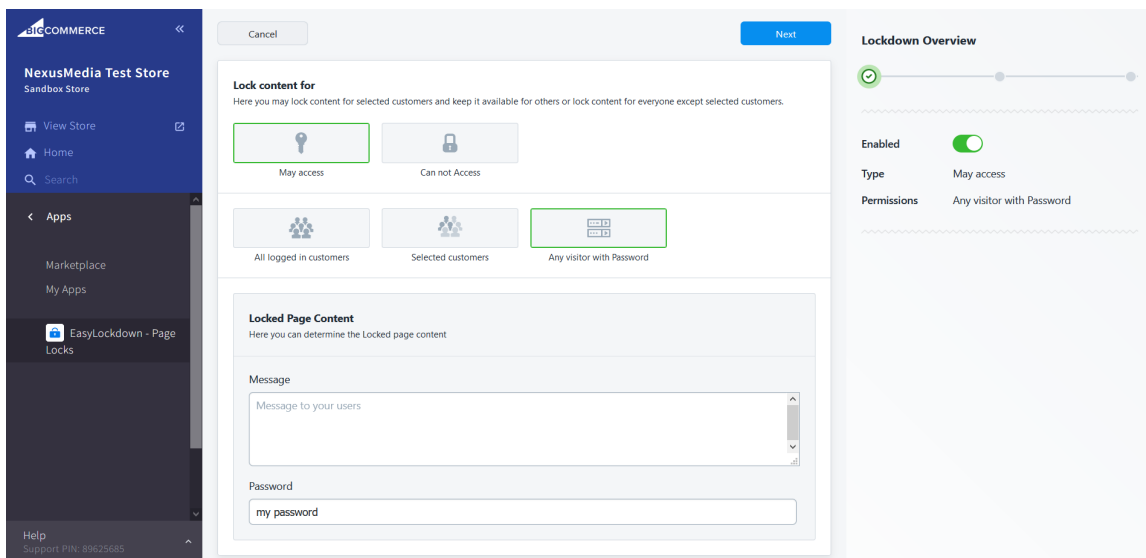
## 2. Select how to limit access to content and customers to lock content for.



Specify certain customers to lock content when May access/Can not access → Selected customers options were chosen.

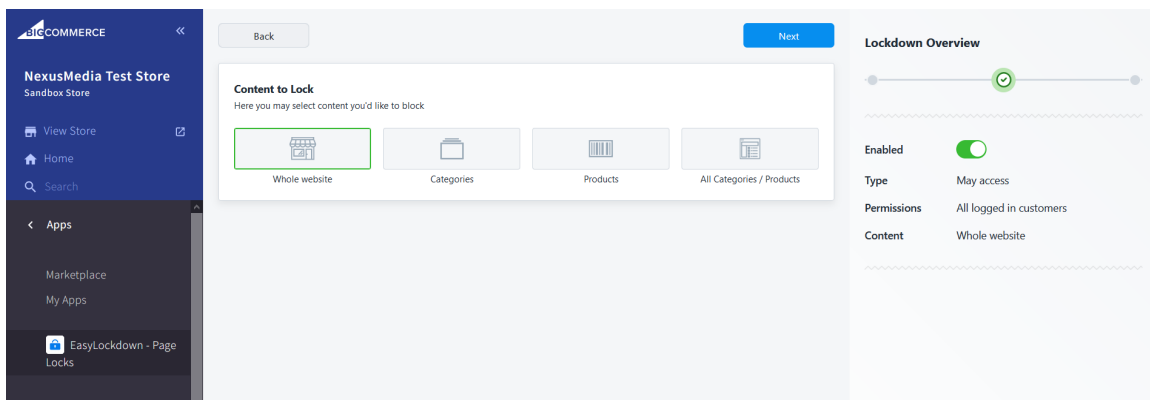


Add password and the related message when May access/Any visitor with password options were chosen.



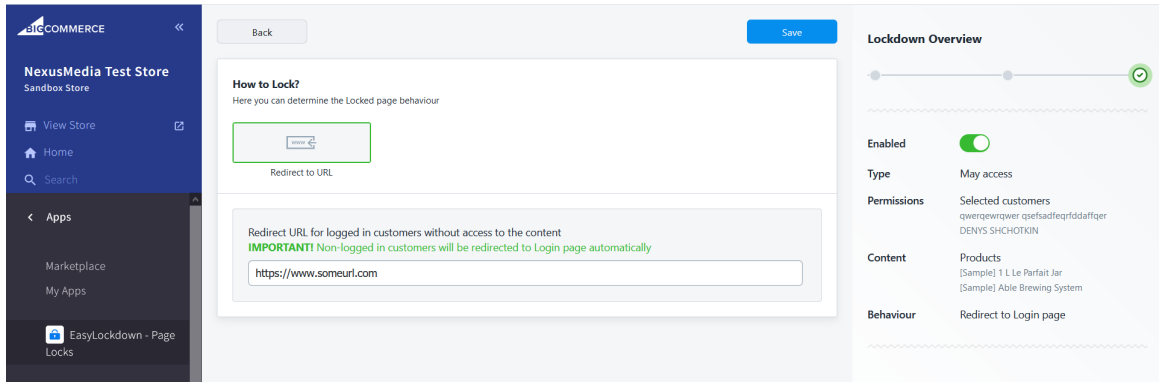
3. Then click the “Next” button.

4. Specify the content to lock.



So that you’ll be able:

- To lock whole website for non-logged in customers.
  - Grant access to pre-order products for specific customer groups.
  - To lock some part of your website from the public.
5. Navigate to next step by clicking “Next” button.
  6. Specify redirect URL for logged in customers without access to the content.



Non-logged in customers will be redirected to Login page automatically.

Locks May access/Any visitor with password will be used a page with password input form and customers should have the password to get access to the content locked.
